18	(a) Unless otherwise provided in statute, the appointing authority for any
19	member of a State board or commission may remove the appointed member
20	for cause prior to the termination of any term. Before removal, the appointed

- 3 (b) Unless otherwise provided in statute, any vacancy in a seat on a State
