18	(a) Subject to subsection (b) of this section, no teacher, administrator, or
19	any other employee of a school district or supervisory union shall be subject to
20	discipline by the school district or supervisory union for testifying before the

1	General Assembly or, a committee of the General Assembly or before, the
2	State Board of Education, a school district board, or a supervisory union board.
3	(b) A teacher, administrator, or <u>any</u> other employee of a school district or
4	supervisory union who testifies before the General Assembly or, a committee
5	of the General Assembly or before, the State Board of Education, a school
6	district board, or a supervisory union board shall not divulge information that
7	is confidential to the school district or supervisory union or to its students or
8	staff and may be disciplined by the individual's employer for divulging such
9	confidential information.
10	(c) A teacher, administrator, or any other employee of a school district or
11	supervisory union who testifies before the General Assembly or, a committee
