Subject: Human services; child care; provider; citizenship status

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to enable a Vermont resident who is a current or prospective early childhood provider to receive a scholarship for current early childhood providers pursuant to 33 V.S.A. § 3541 or a scholarship for prospective early childhood providers pursuant to 33 V.S.A. § 3542, respectively, regardless of the individual's citizenship status. This bill further proposes to enable a Vermont resident to operate a regulated child care facility pursuant to 33 V.S.A. § 3502 regardless of the individual's citizenship status.
