Subject: Transportation; Agency of Transportation; highways; shoulders;
pedestrians; bicyclists

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to improve
pedestrian and bicyclist access along State highways in the designated centers
of rural villages, so as to improve health, promote active lifestyles, and reduce
carbon emissions, by requiring the Agency of Transportation to narrow the
traveled portion of a State highway in a designated center to 11 feet within one
year after a selectboard making such a request.
