The Senate proposes to the House to amend the bill as follows:

First: By adding a reader assistance heading and a new section to be Sec. 1a to read as follows:

§ 123. DUTIES OF OFFICE

(j)(1) The Office may inquire into the criminal background histories of applicants for initial licensure and for license renewal of any Office-issued credential, including a license, certification, registration, or specialty designation for the following professions:

(I) speech-language pathologists licensed under 26 V.S.A. chapter 87; ~~and~~

(J) individuals registered on the roster of psychotherapists who are nonlicensed and noncertified; and

(K) psychologists licensed under 26 V.S.A. chapter 55.

7 (a) On or before September 1, 2024, the Commissioner of the Vermont  
8 Department of Health or designee shall convene the first meeting of the  
9 Naturopathic Physicians Technical Advisory Group. The Technical Advisory  
10 Group shall discuss the potential integration of naturopathic physicians into  
11 statewide policies regarding Vermont's Patient Choice at End of Life laws (18  
12 V.S.A. chapter 113), do not resuscitate (DNR) orders and advanced directives,  
13 and the creation of clinician orders for life-sustaining treatment (COLST). The  
14 Technical Advisory Group shall also consider the requirements of integrating  
15 naturopathic physicians into statewide policies.

16 (b) The Commissioner of the Vermont Department of Health or designee  
17 shall chair any meeting or meetings described in this section.

18 (c) The following individuals and entities shall be invited to participate in  
19 the meeting or meetings described in this section:

- 20 (1) the Association of Accredited Naturopathic Medical Colleges;
