2 An act relating to approval of amendments to the charter of the City of
3 South Burlington

4 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

5 Sec. 1. CHARTER AMENDMENT APPROVAL

6 The General Assembly approves the amendments to the charter of the City
7 of South Burlington as set forth in this act. The voters approved the proposal
8 of amendment on March 5, 2024.

9 Sec. 2. 24 App. V.S.A. chapter 13, subchapter 3 is amended to read:

10 Subchapter 3. Officers

11 § 301. OFFICERS; GENERAL PROVISIONS

12 The officers of the City of South Burlington shall be those provided by law
13 for towns, except as otherwise provided by this charter. The officers shall have
14 all the powers and duties necessary to carry out the provisions of this charter as
15 well as those provided by law. The offices of Fence Viewer, Weigher of Coal,
16 and Inspector of Lumber shall be abolished.

17 (1) The officers of the South Burlington School District shall ~~continue to be~~
18 those provided by law for school or school districts, except as otherwise
19 provided by this charter; provided, however, that the School Directors shall
20 hold no other School District or City office with the exception of the Board of
21 Civil Authority, the Board of Abatement, and as provided otherwise in this

1 charter. When a vacancy occurs on the Board of School Directors, the
2 remaining members of the Board may fill the vacancy until the next annual
3 meeting when the School District shall fill the vacancy.

5 §311. BOARD OF SCHOOL DIRECTORS; NUMBER; TERMS OF
6 OFFICE; ELECTION

7 (a) There shall be a Board of School Directors consisting of seven
8 members.

9 (b) Four members shall have terms of office of three years; three members
10 shall have terms of office of two years.

11 (c) All present School Directors shall serve as Directors until the expiration
12 of their terms and their successors have been duly elected and have qualified.

13 (d) On the first Tuesday in March, 2025, the voters shall elect, from among
14 the legal voters of the city, two members for terms of three years and two
15 members for terms of two years. On the first Tuesday in March, 2026, one
16 member for a term of three years and one member for a term of two years shall
17 be elected. Thereafter, the election of school directors shall be for the length
18 of the term of the member whose term is expiring.

19 (e) All Board of School Directors shall be elected at large.

20 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

21 This act shall take effect on passage.
