13	(a) Greenhouse gas reduction requirements. Vermont shall reduce
14	emissions of greenhouse gases from within the geographical boundaries of the
15	State and those emissions outside the boundaries of the State that are caused by
16	the use of energy in Vermont, as measured and inventoried pursuant to section
17	582 of this title, by:
18	(1) not less than 26 percent from 2005 greenhouse gas emissions by
19	January 1, 2025 2030 pursuant to the State's membership in the United States

1	Climate Alliance and commitment to implement policies to achieve the
2	objectives of the 2016 Paris Agreement;
3	(2) not less than 40 percent from 1990 greenhouse gas emissions by
4	January 1, 2030 2040 pursuant to the State's 2016 Comprehensive Energy
5	Plan; and
6	(3) not less than 80 percent from 1990 greenhouse gas emissions by
7	January 1, 2050 2060 pursuant to the State's 2016 Comprehensive Energy
8	Plan.

20	and economy to adapt to the current and anticipated effects of climate change.

4	2040 greenhouse gas emissions reduction requirement pursuant to section 578
5	of this title. The Secretary shall observe the requirements of subsection (c) of
6	this section.
7	(f) The Secretary shall, at his or her the Secretary's discretion, but not less
8	frequently than once every two years between 2026 2035 and 2030 2040,
9	review and, if necessary, update the rules required by subsection (e) of this
10	section in order to ensure that the 2030 2040 greenhouse gas emissions
11	reduction requirement pursuant to section 578 of this title is achieved. In
12	performing this review and update, the Secretary shall observe the
13	requirements of subsection (c) of this section.
14	(g) On or before July 1, 2040 2050, the Secretary shall adopt and
15	implement rules consistent with the specific initiatives, programs, and
16	strategies set forth in the Plan and updates to the Plan and achieve the 2040
17	2050 greenhouse gas emissions reduction requirement pursuant to section 578
18	of this title.

(h) The Secretary shall, at his or her the Secretary's discretion, but not less

frequently than once every two years between 2040 2050 and 2050 2060,

review and, if necessary, update the rules required by subsection (g) of this

1	section in order to ensure that the 2050 2060 greenhouse gas emissions
2	reduction requirement pursuant to section 578 of this title is achieved. In
3	performing this review and update, the Secretary shall observe the
4	requirements of subsection (c) of this section.
5	(i) The Secretary may establish alternative reduction mechanisms to be
6	used by sources of greenhouse gas emissions, if necessary, to achieve net zero
7	emissions after <u>2050</u> <u>2060</u> .
