2 An act relating to designating Juneteenth as a legal holiday

3 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

4 Sec. 1. 1 V.S.A. § 371(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) The following shall be legal holidays:

6 (1) New Year's Day, January 1;

7 (2) Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Birthday, the third Monday in January;

8 (3) Presidents' Day, the third Monday in February;

9 (4) Town Meeting Day, the first Tuesday in March;

10 (5) Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;

11 (6) Juneteenth, June 19;

12 ~~(6)(7)~~ Independence Day, July 4;

13 ~~(7)(8)~~ Bennington Battle Day, August 16;

14 ~~(8)(9)~~ Labor Day, the first Monday in September;

15 ~~(9)(10)~~ Indigenous Peoples' Day, the second Monday in October;

16 ~~(10)(11)~~ Veterans' Day, November 11;

17 ~~(11)(12)~~ Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November;

18 ~~(12)(13)~~ Christmas Day, December 25.

20 1 V.S.A. § 375 (designating Juneteenth as a commemorative day) is
