11	(1) earns at least one-half of the farmer's annual gross income from the
12	business of farming as that term is defined in Regulation 1.175-3 issued under
13	the Internal Revenue Code of 1986; or
14	(2) is engaged in "farming" as that term is defined in 10 V.S.A.
15	§ 6001(22), regardless of the size of the parcel, and whose gross income from
16	the sale of the farm products equals at least one-half of the farmer's annual
17	gross income.
18	(b) The Small Farmer Diversification and Transition Program is created at
19	the Agency of Agriculture, Food and Markets to provide small farms in
20	Vermont with State financial assistance to diversify production on a farm or to
21	transition from one form of farming to another. Assistance under the Program

6	(4) development of accessory on-farm businesses on a small farm.
7	(b) An applicant for a Small Farmer Diversification and Transition
8	Program grant shall demonstrate to the Secretary of Agriculture, Food and
