




Fungi Facts

- There are about 10,000 kinds of mushrooms in North America.
- The Kingdom Fungi is made up of an estimated 3.5 million species including molds, yeasts and lichens as well as mushrooms
- Fungi are neither plants nor animals. (They do not have chlorophyll. They can be carnivorous and can merge with ants and caterpillars to make virtual cusp species).
- 90% percent of land plant species are associated with fungi that help plants & trees access nutrients (symbiotic relationship)
- Fungi help keep our soils and plants healthy & play an important role in decomposition.
- An increasing vegan population is expected to be a key driver for the global market.
- Mushrooms are considered a superfood owing to their nutritional contents (Shitake have B-12)
- Many mushrooms have medicinal qualities

Windham Elementary School Students

Students at two Windham County Schools learned about **mushrooms**, state symbols and the legislative process with multiple visits this fall. They wanted a mushroom that grew in the Vermont woods & could be cultivated, that grew on trees, was edible, no poison look alikes & had medicinal value. They voted to select Hericium Americanum by a nearly unanimous vote after many comments & debate!

Compass Middle schoolers had two guided mushroom Identification walks at their school prior to helping select the VT State Mushroom. Windham had mycological learning opportunities at their school prior to the State Mushroom project as well. Compass is cultivating mushrooms now, as are the students testifying about mushrooms from Windham Elementary.



Mushroom Economic Factors

- The global mushroom market size was valued at USD 54.9 billion in 2022 and is expected to expand at a compound annual growth rate of 9.7% from 2022 to 2030. In 2030, the mushroom market size is expected to reach \$115.8 billion.
- The US mushroom market was estimated to be over \$4 billion in 2022, growing to over \$9.2 billion in 2030. Vermont's estimated market size was \$7.8 million in 2022, growing to over \$17.9 million in 2030. (Extrapolated based on Grandview Research market report available <u>here</u>)
- The American Mushroom Institute estimates that every pound of mushrooms has \$3.30 of economic impact in the United States and the industry supports over 21,000 jobs. (American Mushroom Institute, available <u>here</u>)

Mushroom Offerings at Vermont State Parks

Mushrooms Demystified - Little River State Park Introducing some fabulous, fearsome and possibly delicious members of the Fungi Kingdom. Meets at the History Hike Parking Lot, up to 2hrs. **11 sessions offered Aug- Oct**

Foraging Walk at Woodford State Park Walk around the park to see and try mushrooms and learn about traditionally medicinal plants. There will be a foraged treat to taste after the walk. **1 session**

Mushroom Madness at Woodford State Park Search for mushrooms throughout the Atwood loop and fungi bingo. Tent at day use area. Materials provided. **1 session**

Teatime: Ethical Foraging Discussion at Lake Carmi State Park Tea made from native plants and learn about ethical foraging & edible plants in Vermont. Program is free for campers or with purchase of day use park pass. (Mushrooms & More) **1 session**

Mushroom Walk at Jamaica State Park Short night hike for mushrooms. Program is included with Camping registration or \$5 state park entry fee. **1 session**

Mushroom Bingo

Pick up a bingo sheet at the center to see how many fungi you can identify. If you get bingo then you can earn a sticker! 1session
