8	(a) The Agency of Agriculture, Food and Markets shall establish the Tree
9	Fruit Farmer Assistance Program consistent with the requirements of this
10	section.
11	(b) A farm in the State that grows tree fruit is eligible for assistance under
12	this section if:
13	(1) the farm is currently operating and producing tree fruit;
14	(2) the farm suffered production losses in calendar year 2023 due to
15	freezing or frost conditions;
16	(3) the farm is in good standing with the Agency of Agriculture, Food
17	and Markets; and
18	(4) the farm submits an application for assistance to the Agency of
19	Agriculture, Food and Markets by a date specified by the Secretary of
20	Agriculture, Food and Markets.

1	(c)(1) The Agency of Agriculture, Food and Markets shall provide
2	financial assistance to farms producing tree fruit in the State in the form of an
3	award to provide relief for losses in calendar year 2023 due to freezing or frost
4	conditions.
5	(2) The Agency of Agriculture, Food and Markets shall develop a
6	formula for calculation of an award under this section. The formula shall
7	incorporate:
8	(A) the average value per pound of each eligible tree fruit as a raw
9	agricultural commodity;
10	(B) the total production losses of a farm in calendar year 2023;
11	(C) a maximum award amount of 20 percent of a farm's production
12	losses; and
13	(D) a reduction in the maximum amount of the award per farm so
14	that the award does not exceed the total of uncovered losses at the farm.
15	(d) The Agency shall process applications for a grant in the order
16	applications are received. If all funds appropriated for implementation of this
17	section are awarded by the Agency, no further grants shall be made. If any
18	funds appropriated for implementation of this section remain after all timely
19	applications are processed, the remaining funds shall be transferred to the
20	Working Lands Enterprise Fund not later than December 31, 2024 for award
