## TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

- The Committee on Agriculture, Food Resiliency, and Forestry to which was referred Senate Bill No. 115 entitled "An act relating to miscellaneous agricultural subjects" respectfully reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the House propose to the Senate that the bill be amended by striking out Secs. 8 and 9, report on municipal regulation of stormwater, in their entireties and inserting in lieu thereof new Secs. 8 and 9 to read as follows:
- Sec. 8. 24 V.S.A. § 4414(9) is amended to read:
- (9) Stormwater management and control. Any municipality may adopt bylaws to implement stormwater management and control consistent with the program developed by the Secretary of Natural Resources pursuant to 10 V.S.A. § 1264. Municipalities shall not charge a fee under this subdivision or under other provisions of this title for discharges of agricultural waste or agricultural nonpoint source pollution, including stormwater runoff from impervious surfaces that are managed pursuant to the Required Agricultural Practices.

## 18 Sec. 9. IMPLEMENTATION PROSPECTIVE APPLICATION

Sec. 8 (municipal stormwater fees on agricultural nonpoint source

pollution) of this act shall apply prospectively and shall not require a

municipality to refund stormwater operating fees assessed prior to the effective

1	date of this act on properties or activities that are exempt from such fees under
