- Ecosystem Services (clean water, oxygen, wildlife habitat, etc.)
- Carbon sequestration and storage
- Recreation and tourism
- Maple and other non-timber products
- > Timber





- > 75% of Vermont is forested
- > 80% percent of the forested land in Vermont is privately owned
- The majority of those acres are owned by small, individual woodlot owners.
- > The majority of these landowners are older than 55.





- Our forests are growing at more than twice the rate of harvest and mortality every year
- We are losing between 2,500 11,000 acres of forest <u>permanently</u> every year to non-forest development





Vermont's forest economy provides more than 13,000 jobs, more than \$2 billion in direct economic output, and supports the growing outdoor recreational and tourism sectors.






- Climate change is expected to continue to exacerbate the threats that invasive plants, insects, and diseases already pose to the health of Vermont's forests. (Vermont Climate Assessment, 2021)
- As climate change impacts forest ecosystem function, there is a need for management to increase forest adaptive capacity. (Vermont Climate Assessment, 2021)








Vermont Forest Products Jobs
