An applicant shall not be denied solely on the basis of 12 a criminal conviction that is not listed in 13 V.S.A. chapter 25 or 28 conduct a 13 name and date of birth Vermont criminal conviction record background check 14 and obtain information from the Child Protection Registry maintained by the 15 Department for Children and Families and from the Vulnerable Adult Abuse, 16 Neglect, and Exploitation Registry maintained by the Department of 17 Disabilities, Aging, and Independent Living (collectively, the Registries) for 18 any person who applies to be a caregiver. The Departments for Children and
