
They answered the call and defended our Country, for that reason, our staff is here for them.

Medicaid Settlement Dollars

- These dollars are from FY 2021 and total \$4,298,053
- Facility is giving and interim rate of and after the cost report is reviewed, we receive the difference between the interim rate an out actual cost.
- Agency of Human Services applied for a wavier from Medicare that allows VVH to receive our full cost of care for our Medicaid residents.

Budget Adjustment Request

- To track/account for the Medicaid settlement.
- Increase in Agency/Travel Nurses
 - 50% of current staff
 - Beds "offline"
- Inflation impacting all cost centers.
- Inability of contracted suppliers to proved goods and services

- Agency Staff \$5,850,574
- Other categories total \$1,366,802 which was offset by an increase of \$1,332,534 in Vacancy Savings due to an increase in open positions
