I am here today to ask for support of the Vermont Access Network - our state's 24 Community Media (PEG TV) Centers - with a one-time bridge funding appropriation of \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2024, as third-year of bridge funding to a secure funding stream to replace declining cable revenues.
