### **INVESTING IN VERMONT**

- \$17,246 in Scholarships and Financial Aid for every Vermonter attending UVM Average, per student receiving aid
- \$14,946 average debt for UVM in-state undergraduate students
- 33% of physicians in Vermont graduated from UVM's Larner College of Medicine. Among Vermont primary care physicians, 40% studied at UVM
- **91%** of **undergraduate seniors engaged** in research, an internships or other experience-based learning/high impact practices while at UVM

More than half of UVM's state funding directly supports Vermont student scholarships and financial aid.
