This letter is mailed to each owner of record and, if there's a lien holder, a copy is sent to them as well. The next two pages are the totals for 2021 and 2022. As stated earlier today I will get the county by country break down on Monday and will send that under separate cover. For comparison, below I have shared the 2019 and 2020 county by county numbers. Please note on the total pages the amounts include those vehicles that were titles and ones that were not titled. The county by county numbers are for titled vehicles only, which will explain why the numbers wont match.

We do not track those that are denied so I am unable to provide an answer for question 3. As for question 4 we do not electronically track that data so in order to answer that question each application would need to be manually pulled and reviewed.
