### Working Lands Coalition

- -Request is to make the \$3 million in one-time funds be converted to base funding
- -Encourage House Commerce in policy memo to House Appropriations due March 1st to convert this one-time funding to base funding
- -Justification for Demand
  - -Previous FY \$7 million was appropriated
  - -This year received \$1 million base funding + \$3 million one-time funding
  - -Decrease in ability to address demand
- -Sending out one-pager on the need for funding and breakdown of demand

#### RDCs and RPCs

- -Influx of state and federal resources has exposed the fact that RPCs have been underfunded for "decades"
  - -Has held back the capacity to adequately address community needs

#### -BAA

- -Trying to ensure that the flow of the \$3 million to communities is done effectively
- -Intent on making sure the selected communities are underserved and actually want help
- -Distribution of funds:
  - -Helping Deputy Secretary find ways to expedite the program
- -RPCs have been providing technical assistance to towns receiving ARPA funding
  - -Assisting in how to use this funding and how to supplement this funding
- -Canadian Jobs
  - -Companies in Canada that want to establish themselves in VT
  - -How do you address brownfield mediations
    - -May expedite attraction to new companies
  - -RDCs are in discussion with Canadian companies about coming to VT
  - -3 tools can be used:
    - -VEGI
- -Hope to keep the program and make some tweaks to it to provide data to the legislature so they know its working
  - -Rural and Regional Growth Fund
  - -Money in the budget for Brownfields
