Considerations

MA Regulation Changes 2012

- Established to regulate 26 collaboratives across the state
- Attempted to create fewer, change what agency could provide (5 Regions/Adult Services)
- Model language for articles of agreement formed the basis for governance

Vermont Proposal H-0630

- Opportunity to define all aspects of regional service agencies and create the structure
- Can learn from challenges in other states as more than 35 states have a similar system.
- Much needed shared services for rural areas

VT Agency of Education Role

Number of agencies

- Define number across the state in advance
- Create boundaries based on VT existing structures (i.e VT South, VT Central, VT North)

Governance

- Board of Directors- Define who can hold seat
- Articles of Agreement
- o By-Laws

Membership

- Establish boundaries and create ability to procure programs/services outside that boundary
- Offer member/Non-Member rates and establish the maximum differential (i.e. no more than 25%)

VT Agency of Education Role

- Funding
 - Define funding opportunities (if any)
 - Allow for grant participation for and with school unions
- Services provided
 - Specialized Programs?
 - Staff Recruitment/Resources?
 - o Evaluation Center?
 - Early Childhood Programs?
 - Adult Services?
 - Cooperative Purchasing?
 - o Professional Development?
 - ODE Initiative Implementation?
 - Transportation?

Additional Considerations

- Remain a viable entity for educational professionals to gain employment by allowing similar benefits (insurance, VT retirement, licensure)
- Consider funding opportunities or resource allocation (i.e. school building funding tied to BOCES space)
- 3. Allow for specialization state-wide (i.e PD, transportation, cooperative purchase)
