



# OPPORTUNITIES FOR MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS



## Access Days

Middle and high school students have the chance to experience CCV for a day. Students attend mock classes, hear from current CCV students, and explore potential career paths.

## Intro to College & Careers

Students in 8th-12th grades can take this free course to prepare for college and start thinking about career options.

## Dual Enrollment

Juniors and seniors are eligible for two Dual Enrollment vouchers, each good for one free college course. Free credits earned at CCV also count toward high school graduation.

## Early College

Seniors can spend their entire senior year of high school enrolled as full-time CCV students, earning a year of free college credits that also count toward high school graduation.

## Free Degree Promise

With generous support from the J. Warren & Lois McClure Foundation, the Free Degree Promise gives students in the Vermont high school classes of 2024-2026 the opportunity to build on their Early College year and complete a CCV associate degree at no cost.
