


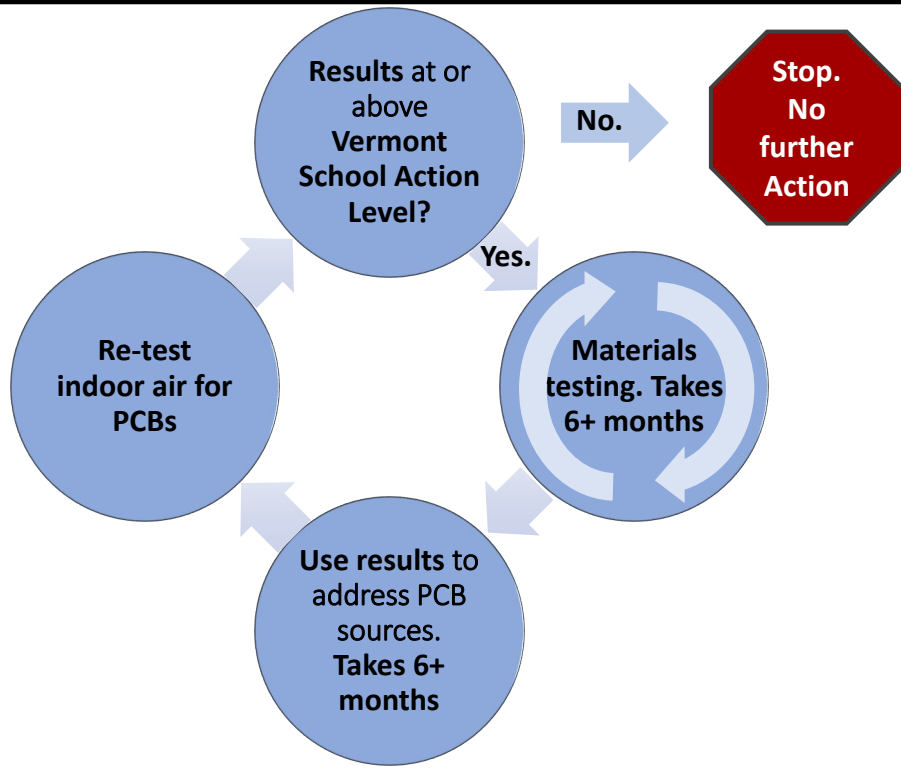
Overview of PCB Testing & Next Steps in Vermont Schools

Information for School Officials

Send a notification letter to your community before testing begins.

Templates are available at dec.vermont.gov/pcb-schools.

If PCBs are detected in indoor air at or above the School Action Level  **School Action:** Implement an occupancy option that keeps your school open. Hire a consultant within 6 weeks. <https://bit.ly/pcb-consultants>



Materials testing is collecting building materials to be tested for PCBs. This can be an iterative process.

Work can occur on school breaks, weekends and other times when school is not in session.

Your consultant will conduct work under state direction and approval.
