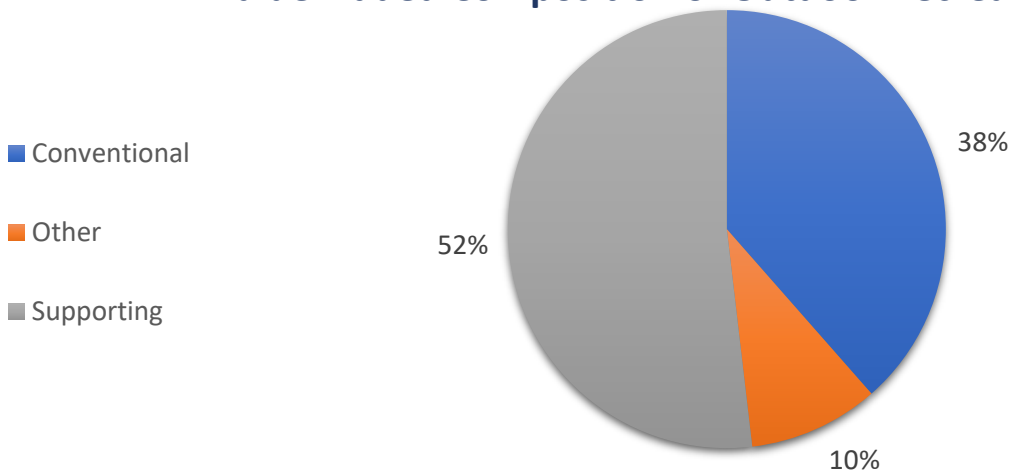

**Conventional ORSA** activities include traditional outdoor activities, such as camping, hiking, boating, and hunting.

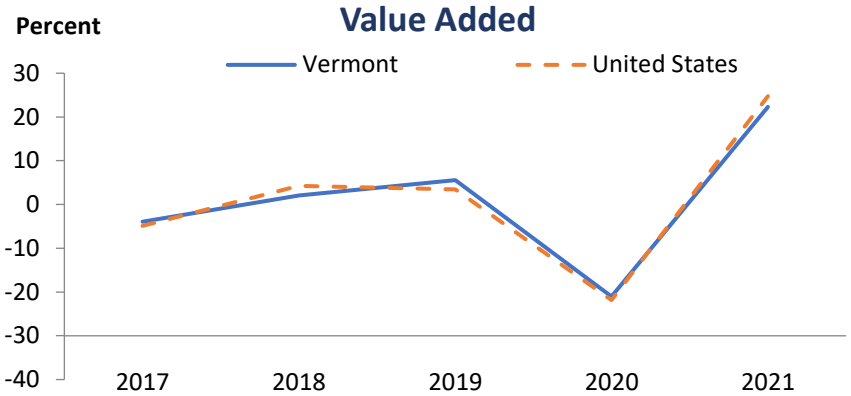
**Other ORSA** activities include those that take place outside, such as gardening and outdoor concerts.

**Supporting ORSA** activities are those that contribute to the core activities and include such things as construction, travel and tourism, local trips, and government expenditures.

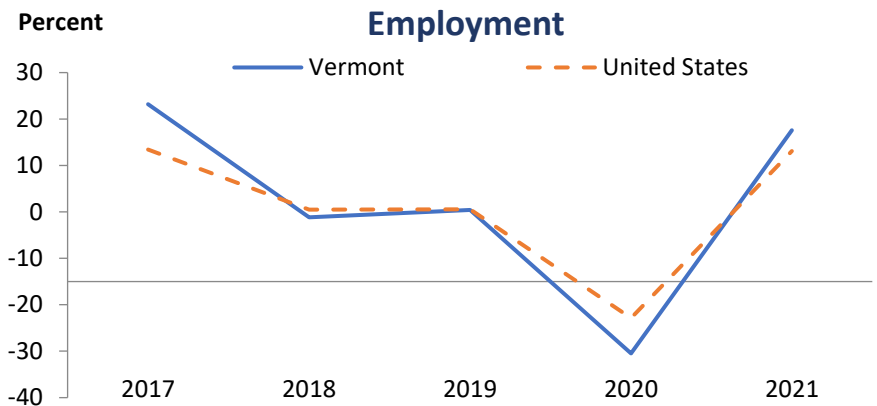
# Outdoor Recreation Satellite Account (ORSA)



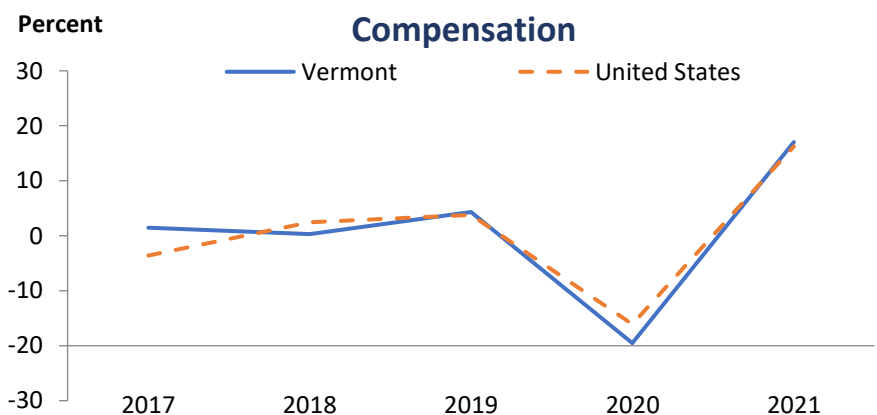
In 2021, Vermont ranked 45th among all states in ORSA value added and 32nd among all states in ORSA value-added growth. Since 2020, ORSA value added has grown 22.3 percent in Vermont, compared with an increase of 24.7 percent for the United States.



In 2021, Vermont ranked 49th among all states in ORSA employment and 8th among all states in ORSA employment growth. Since 2020, ORSA employment has grown 17.6 percent in Vermont, compared with an increase of 13.1 percent for the United States.



In 2021, Vermont ranked 48th among all states in ORSA compensation and 19th among all states in ORSA compensation growth. Since 2020, ORSA compensation has grown 17 percent in Vermont, compared with an increase of 16.2 percent for the United States. Average compensation per wage-and-salary job in Vermont ORSA industries was \$43,527 in 2021, compared with \$68,475 for all salaried jobs in the state.



**ORSA value added** consists of the gross output of an industry less its intermediate inputs; the contribution of an industry to gross domestic product.

**ORSA employment** consists of all wage-and-salary jobs in which workers are engaged in the production of ORSA goods and services.

**ORSA compensation** consists of the remuneration (including wages and salaries as well as benefits, such as employer contributions to pension and health funds) payable to employees in return for their ORSA work during a given year.
