- (d) Assistance. The Working Group shall have the administrative, technical, and legal assistance of the Department of Public Service and technical assistance of the Department of Public Service. The Working Group shall have the legal assistance of the Department of Public Service as to matters of procedure; the Working Group's powers and duties; existing State programs; existing legal requirements or obligations; and the drafting of proposed legislation. The Working Group may hire a third-party consultant to assist and staff the Working Group, which may be funded by monies appropriated by the General Assembly, or any grant funding received.
- (e) Report. On or before January 15, 2025, and annually until 2030 January 15, 2025, the Working Group shall submit a written report to the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and Energy and the House Committee on Environment and Energy with its findings and recommendations for legislative action.
- (f) Meetings.
  - (1) The Department of Public Service shall call the first meeting of the Working Group to occur on or before July 15, 2024.
  - (2) The Working Group shall elect a chair from among its members at the first meeting.
  - (3) A majority of the membership shall constitute a quorum.
  - (4) The Working Group shall cease to exist on February 15, 202530.
