- April 2017: Act 149 (2017) signed by Governor Scott

- January 2019: proposed updates to statute to comply with EPA requirements
- Feb 2019: Draft rule sent to stakeholders for review (similar list to above)
- Feb 2019: EPA RRP program authorization kick-off meeting
- April 2019: Updated lead legislation signed by Governor Scott
- July 2019: EPA review of draft rule
- October 2019: Discussed licensing issues in rule with EPA
- January 2020: Sent rule to stakeholders for review
- April 2020- ICAR
- May 2020- Public comment period
- July 2020 Public hearing
- January 2021: Response to comments on rule-
- LCAR April 2021
- April 2021 Final Adopted Rule Filed

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
