15	(3) for a third or subsequent violation of this subsection, be fined not
16	more than \$150,000.00 or imprisoned not more than two years, or both.
17	(b) An operator who violates a provision of this chapter shall be fined:
18	(1) for a first violation, not more than \$25,000.00;
19	(2) for a second violation, not more than \$75,000.00; and
20	(3) for a third violation, not more than \$150,000.00.
