15	Economic Development, Housing and General Affairs and on Health and
16	Welfare regarding the results of the 2024 Tobacco Retail Audit.
17	(2) The report shall include detailed findings regarding the physical
18	placement of beverage alcohol products within licensed retail establishments.
19	(3) The report shall take the form of a presentation to each of the
20	Committees.
