1	TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
2	The Committee on Government Operations and Military Affairs to which
3	was referred Senate Bill No. 39 entitled "An act relating to compensation and
4	benefits for members of the Vermont General Assembly" respectfully reports
5	that it has considered the same and recommends that the House propose to the
6	Senate that the bill be amended as follows:
7	First: In Sec. 4, 32 V.S.A. § 1052, in subdivision (a)(3), by striking out "is
8	entitled to" and inserting in lieu thereof "may claim"
9	Second: In Sec. 4, 32 V.S.A. § 1052, by striking out subsection (b) in its
10	entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (b) to read as follows:
11	(b) Expenses. During any session of the General Assembly, each member
12	is entitled to receive an allowance for or reimbursement of expenses as
13	follows: set forth in this subsection.
14	(1) Mileage reimbursement. Reimbursement Each member shall receive
15	reimbursement in an amount equal to the actual mileage traveled for each day
16	of session in which the member travels between Montpelier and the member's
17	home or from Montpelier or from the member's home to another site on
18	officially sanctioned legislative business. Reimbursement of actual mileage
19	traveled under this subdivision shall be at the rate per mile determined by the
20	federal Office of Government-wide Policy and published in the Federal
21	Register for the year of the session.

1	(2) Meals and lodging allowance. Each member shall receive either a
2	meals allowance or reimbursement of actual meals expenses. A member shall
3	be presumed to have elected to receive the meals allowance unless the member
4	informs the Office of Legislative Operations prior to the convening of the
5	regular or adjourned session that the member wishes to receive reimbursement
6	of actual meals expenses. A member's election to receive reimbursement of
7	actual meals expenses shall remain in effect through the remainder of that
8	session unless the member notifies the Office, in writing, that the member
9	needs to change to the meals allowance due to a change in circumstances or for
10	another compelling reason.
11	(A) Meals allowance. An A member who elects to receive a meals
12	allowance in shall receive an amount equal to the daily amount for meals and
13	lodging determined for Montpelier, Vermont, by the federal Office of
14	Government-wide Policy and published in the Federal Register for the year of
15	the session, for each day the House in which the member serves shall sit.
16	(B) Meals reimbursement. A member who elects to receive
17	reimbursement of expenses shall receive reimbursement equal to the actual
18	amounts expended by the member for meals for each day that the House in
19	which the member serves shall sit, as well as meals for the night preceding the
20	first legislative day of each week during the legislative session; provided,
21	however, that the total amount of the weekly reimbursement available pursuant

1	to this subdivision shall not exceed the amount the member would have
2	received for the same week if the member had elected the meals allowance
3	pursuant to subdivision (A) of this subdivision (2). The member shall provide
4	meal receipts or otherwise substantiate the amounts expended to the Office of
5	Legislative Operations in the form and manner prescribed by the Director of
6	Legislative Operations.
7	(3) Lodging. Each member shall receive either a lodging allowance or
8	reimbursement of actual lodging expenses. A member shall be presumed to
9	have elected to receive the lodging allowance unless the member informs the
10	Office of Legislative Operations prior to the convening of the regular or
11	adjourned session that the member wishes to receive reimbursement of actual
12	lodging expenses. A member's election to receive reimbursement of actual
13	lodging expenses shall remain in effect through the remainder of that session
14	unless the member notifies the Office, in writing, that the member needs to
15	change to the lodging allowance due to a change in circumstances or for
16	another compelling reason.
17	(A) Lodging allowance. A member who elects to receive a lodging
18	allowance shall receive an amount equal to the daily amount for lodging
19	determined for Montpelier, Vermont, by the federal Office of Government-
20	wide Policy and published in the Federal Register for the year of the session
21	for each day the House in which the member serves shall sit.

1	(B) Lodging reimbursement. A member who elects to receive
2	reimbursement of expenses shall receive reimbursement equal to the actual
3	amounts expended by the member for lodging for each day that the House in
4	which the member serves shall sit, as well as lodging for the night preceding
5	the first legislative day of each week during the legislative session; provided,
6	however, that the total amount of the weekly reimbursement available pursuant
7	to this subdivision for each week shall not exceed the amount the member
8	would have received for the same week if the member had elected the lodging
9	allowance pursuant to subdivision (A) of this subdivision (3). The member
10	shall provide lodging receipts or otherwise substantiate the amounts expended
11	to the Office of Legislative Operations in the form and manner prescribed by
12	the Director of Legislative Operations.
13	(4) Absences. If a member is absent for reasons other than sickness or
14	legislative business for one or more entire days while the house in which the
15	member sits is in session, the member shall notify the Office of Legislative
16	Operations of that absence, and expenses received shall not include the amount
17	that the legislator specifies was not incurred the member shall not receive or be
18	reimbursed for mileage, meals, or lodging expenses incurred during the period
19	of that absence.
20	Third: In Sec. 6, Legislative Service Working Group, in subdivision (c)(1),
21	by adding a new subdivision to be subdivision (C) to read as follows:

1	(C) the impact of making members eligible for the State
2	employees' health plan as set forth in Sec. 1 of this act on members of
3	different income levels;
4	and by relettering the remaining subdivisions in subdivision (c)(1) to be
5	alphabetically correct
6	Fourth: In Sec. 6, Legislative Service Working Group, in subsection (g), by
7	striking out "eight" preceding "meetings" in the first sentence and inserting in
8	lieu thereof " <u>six</u> "
9	Fifth: By striking out Sec. 7, appropriation, and its reader assistance
10	heading in their entireties and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
11	Sec. 7. [Deleted.]
12	Sixth: In Sec. 8, effective dates, by striking out subsections (b) and (c) in
13	their entireties and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
14	(b) Secs. 3(b)(3) (expenses for Speaker and President Pro Tempore)
15	and 4(b)–(d) (legislator expenses) shall take effect on January 1, 2024.
16	and by relettering the remaining subsections to be alphabetically correct
17
