#### Implementation Progress in Year 1: Administrative Successes



- 1. Strong leadership and transparency
- 2. Timely communication about implementation, namely from the Child Development Division
- 3. Simplified applications for funding based on community feedback
- 4. CCFAP is now an entitlement program in Vermont that cannot have a waitlist
- 5. Establishment of First Children's Finance to build capacity to support child care businesses, provide technical support, and partner on monitoring efforts
- 6. Prekindergarten Education Implementation Committee strong facilitation, monthly full committee and subcommittee meetings, 2 key documents produced
  - a. Quality Matrixb. Systems Matrix
- 7. Collaborative approach to monitoring & dissemination (8 entities)

# Implementation Progress in Year 1: Preliminary Data



- Readiness payment program disseminated \$21M to ~800 child care programs (input from 378 programs)
- <u>CCFAP expansion</u> has been rolling out as directed
  - Paying out 34% more to programs on behalf of families - \$8.74M in March 2024 vs \$5.78M in March 2023
- <u>First eligibility expansion</u> was in place on April 7th
  - As of May, 141 families above 350% FPL were approved
  - For a family of four with two children in child care, they would mean they are now paying \$250/week when before they could have easily been paying \$800/week



# Implementation Progress in Year 1: Preliminary Data



- Significantly fewer programs have decreased enrollment
- More child care program openings than closures
- Increased licensed capacity
- Collaborative focus on capacity building
- Benefits for ECE to value and recruit and retain staff
- Optimism about child care businesses, the state's investment, and the value of ECE
- New programs preparing for licensure, to hire staff, increase benefits, upgrade facilities, & increase compensation
