11	experiencing sexual abuse before 18 years of age. In over 90 percent of
12	incidents of child sexual abuse, the perpetrator is someone known and trusted
13	by the child and the child's family.
14	and by renumbering the remaining sections to be numerically correct.
15	Second: In the newly renumbered Sec. 2, purpose, by striking out
16	subsections (a) and (c) in their entireties and by relettering the remaining
17	subsections to be alphabetically correct and in the newly relettered subsection
18	(a), after "community", by inserting with intent.
