6	the Court Technology Fund. The Judiciary shall include the annualized
7	amounts necessary to support these expenditures in its fiscal year 2026 budget
8	presentation.
9	Second: In subsection (c), in subdivision (2)(A), by striking out subdivision
10	(iv) in its entirety and renumbering the remaining subdivisions to be
11	numerically correct
12	Third: By adding a new subsection (j) to read as follows:
13	(j) It is the intent of the General Assembly to use a portion of the revenues
14	generated through the amended taxes and fees in Secs. 3-5 of this act to fund
15	the appropriations set forth in this section.
