Please reconsider the proposed legislation for bill H.89. H.89 is clearly legislation meant to protect physicians, pharmaceutical companies, psychiatrists, and other healthcare providers who are pushing gender affirming care on susceptible unhappy children and teens before these teens and children are ready to fully weigh what it would mean to them to transition. It is now clear that many of these children and teens later regret their choices including taking puberty blockers, hormones, or undergoing mutilating surgery.
