House resolution authorizing limited remote committee voting through the first Friday of the 2024 Adjourned Session

Offered by: Committee on Rules

Resolved by the House of Representatives:

That through Friday, January 5, 2024, each member of a House committee is authorized to vote remotely in that committee:

- (1) if the member has tested positive for COVID-19 and is within a required period of isolation as provided by Vermont Department of Health guidelines; and
- (2) for not more than three days, for any other reason, and be it further Resolved: Such a member shall notify the committee chair and clerk that the member is exercising this remote voting authority, and shall count toward a committee quorum, and be it further

Resolved: The committee clerk shall record any vote cast by the member as a remote vote, and shall track the number of days the member exercises the member's non-COVID-19 remote voting authority.
