5	(a) The Agency of Transportation, in partnership with regional planning
6	commissions through the annual Transportation Planning Initiative, shall
7	conduct a survey of municipal support for the creation of a bicycle corridor—
8	consisting of one or more segments of bicycle lanes or bicycle paths, or both—
9	to provide a safe means of travel via bicycle on or along a route that is roughly
10	adjacent to U.S. Route 5 for the approximately 190 miles spanning between the
11	State border with Massachusetts and the State border with Quebec, Canada.
12	(b) The survey shall address the level of interest of municipalities and
13	regional planning commissions in prioritizing the creation of a bicycle corridor
