

1 Sec. 14. VALIDATION STICKER REQUIREMENTS IN RULE

2 (a) Registration and Operation of Snowmobiles, Approved Helmets and
3 VAST Snowmobile Registrations.

4 (1) Notwithstanding, Department of Motor Vehicles, Registration and
5 Operation of Snowmobiles, Approved Helmets and VAST Snowmobile
6 Registrations (CVR 14-050-027), Secs. I(3)(a) and III:

7 (A) the Department of Motor Vehicles shall not issue temporary and
8 permanent validation stickers, temporary and permanent validating stickers, or
9 “S” stickers;

10 (B) operators of snowmobiles shall not be required to display
11 temporary or permanent validation stickers, temporary or permanent validating
12 stickers, or “S” stickers; and

13 (C) the Vermont Association of Snow Travelers (VAST) shall not be
14 required to maintain a log of “S” stickers or have unused registration “S”
15 stickers available for inspection in Department of Motor Vehicles audits, nor
16 shall VAST agents be eligible to issue “S” stickers.

17 (2) The Department of Motor Vehicles shall amend the Approved
18 Helmets and VAST Snowmobile Registrations rule to eliminate requirements
19 related to temporary and permanent validation stickers, temporary and
20 permanent validating stickers, and “S” stickers the next time the rule is
21 amended pursuant to 3 V.S.A. chapter 25.

1 (b) Vermont Dealer Licensing and Schedule of Penalties and Suspension.

2 (1) Notwithstanding Department of Motor Vehicles, Vermont Dealer
3 Licensing and Schedule of Penalties and Suspension (CVR 14-050-050), Sec.
4 VI(j), there shall not be an administrative penalty assessed for a dealer failing
5 to display a validation sticker on a dealer’s registration plate.

6 (2) The Department of Motor Vehicles shall amend the Vermont Dealer
7 Licensing and Schedule of Penalties and Suspension rule to eliminate the
8 administrative penalty for a dealer failing to display a validation sticker on a
9 dealer’s registration plate the next time the rule is amended pursuant to 3
10 V.S.A. chapter 25.
