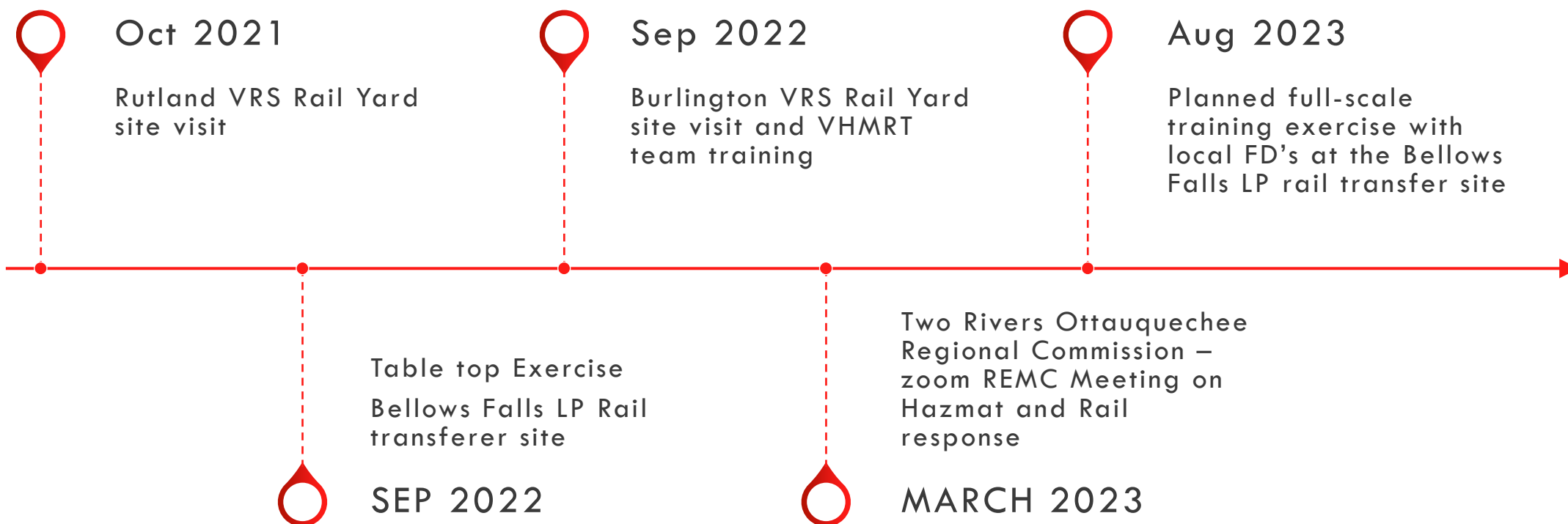
VRS PARTNERSHIP

- Annual Tier II Reporting by the Railroad

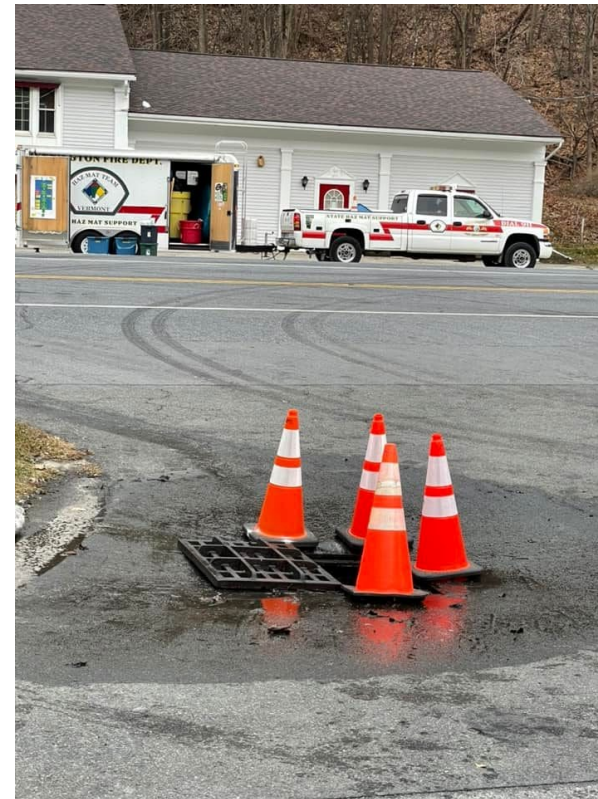
