(2) Prior to the entry of any divorce or annulment proceeding in the Superior Court, there shall be paid to the clerk of the court for the benefit of the State a fee of \$295.00 \$360.00 in lieu of all other fees not otherwise set forth in this section. If the divorce or annulment complaint is filed with a stipulation for a final order, the fee shall be \$90.00 \$110.00 if one or both of the parties are residents and \$180.00 \$220.00 if neither party is a resident, except that if the stipulation is not acceptable to the court or if a matter previously agreed to becomes contested, the difference between the full fee and the reduced fee shall be paid to the court prior to the issuance of a final order.
