2	Working Group), and 14 (Wealth Tax Commission) shall take effect on
3	passage.
4	(b) Notwithstanding 1 V.S.A. § 214, Secs. 3 and 4 (link to federal income
5	tax laws) shall take effect retroactively on January 1, 2024 and apply to taxable
6	years beginning on and after January 1, 2023.
