18	Second: By deleting the newly renumbered Sec. 4, effective dates, and
19	inserting a new Sec. 4 to read as follows:

1	Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATES
2	This section and Sec. 2 (3 V.S.A. § 123(j)(1)) shall take effect on July 1,
3	2023. Sec. 1 (clinical mental health counselors) and Sec. 3 (fees) shall take
4	effect on July 1, 2024.
