

1 TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

2 The Committee on Ways and Means to which was referred House Bill No.
3 77 entitled “An act relating to Vermont’s adoption of the Physical Therapy
4 Licensure Compact” respectfully reports that it has considered the same and
5 recommends that the bill be amended as follows:

6 First: By striking out Sec. 3, effective dates, its entirety and inserting in lieu
7 thereof new a Sec. 3 and Sec. 4 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 3. 3 V.S.A. § 125 is amended to read:

9 § 125. FEES

11 (b) Unless otherwise provided by law, the following fees shall apply to all
12 professions regulated by the Director in consultation with advisor appointees
13 under Title 26:

15 (4) Biennial renewal, \$240.00, except biennial renewal for:

17 (C) Physical therapists and assistants, \$150.00, except that a licensee
18 of a remote state under the Physical Therapy Licensure Compact established in
19 26 V.S.A. chapter 38, subchapter 5 shall pay a biennial \$50.00 privilege to
20 practice fee.

1 Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATES

2 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2023, except that Sec. 1 (physical
3 therapist licensure compact) and Sec. 3 (fees) shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
