10	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
11	Sec. 1. REPORT; DEPARTMENT OF TAXES; REVENUE SOURCES TO
12	FUND EDUCATION
13	(a) On or before January 15, 2024, the Department of Taxes shall submit a
14	written report to the House Committees on Education and on Ways and Means
15	and the Senate Committees on Education and on Finance regarding new or
16	alternative revenue sources for the Education Fund to replace the revenues
17	generated by the education property tax, in the event of its repeal. The
18	Department shall analyze and propose options to replace education property
19	tax revenue, including:

1	(1) Expanding the tax structures of existing Education Fund revenue
2	sources. The recommendation required under this subdivision shall include an
3	analysis of the sales and use tax and the meals and rooms tax, including
4	imposing sales and use tax on services and repealing, to the extent permitted
5	under federal and constitutional law, exemptions and expenditures under any
6	of the tax types that are currently Education Fund revenue sources.
7	(2) Creating a new, broad-based tax type.
8	(b) In conducting its analysis for the report required under this section, the
9	Department shall incorporate the relevant studies as follows:
10	(1) Vermont Tax Structure Commission created by 2018 (Sp. Sess.)
11	Acts and Resolves No. 11;
12	(2) Blue Ribbon Tax Structure Commission created by 2009 (Sp. Sess.)
13	Acts and Resolves No. 1; and
14	(3) any other studies of Vermont's education finance system since the
15	enactment of 1998 Acts and Resolves No. 60 and 2004 Acts and Resolves No.
