

Statewide Request for Proposals (RFP) for FY26 Community and Restorative Justice Services

KEY DATES:

- October 25, 2024- Issuance of RFP
- O January 31, 2025- Proposals due
- July 1, 2025- Start of grants

FUNDING MODEL:

- \$100,000 base per provider
- \$75,000 additional per region with facilities
- Remainder proportionally divided based on Probation & Parole office headcount

OUTPUTS

 Services delivered through a regional structure in partnership with corresponding DOC Correctional Facilities, Probation & Parole Offices, and District Courts

- Statewide service capacities:
 - Facility-based Restorative Justice program development
 - Reentry Navigation
 - Circles of Support and Accountability (COSA)
 - Post-Adjudication Reparative Panels (with or without Probation)

Equitable allocation of resources




IMPACT
