Dear Members of the Legislative Committee on Administrative Rules:

After the Vermont Department of Liquor and Lottery ("Department") submitted our final proposed rule (Department of Liquor and Lottery, Administrative Rules Update 22-P37), we received additional public input and feedback from the Break-Open Ticket Wholesale industry and from Non-Profit Organizations that utilize Break-Open Tickets to generate revenue for their respective causes. That input shed additional light relative to the potential economic impact of the filed proposed rule change that merits additional study.

In response to that feedback, the Department now wishes to amend our proposed rule by removing proposed General Regulation 47(d).

The rest of the Department's final proposed rule remains unchanged. Along with this letter, I am also submitting a revised redline and clean version of the final proposed Rule 22-P37 to reflect this change. The Department does extend an apology for filing this update with such short notice and beyond the filing deadlines. Our intent is to be inclusive and reflective of industry feedback as possible, even at this late hour in the process.

Please let me know if you have any questions. We look forward to discussing proposed Rule 22-P37 at the upcoming April 27th, 2023, meeting of LCAR.
