Dear Members of the Legislative Committee on Administrative Rules:

In response to feedback received from Legislative Counsel, the Enhanced 911 Board (Board) proposes the following modifications to final proposed rule 23P010, Rule Governing Outage Reporting Requirements for Originating Carriers and Electric Power Companies:

- Section 1.0: Corrected citation to read: "This rule is adopted pursuant to Vt. Act 79, Sec. 25 (2019) as amended by Vt. Act 125, Sec. 4 (2020) and 30 V.S.A. § 7053."
- Section 3.3: removed "but is not limited to" in accordance with <u>1 V.S.A. § 145</u> ("The terms 'include,' includes,' and 'including' mean that the language following the term is illustrative and not exhaustive, and shall have the same meaning as though the term were followed by the words 'but not limited to."").
- Sections 4.5, 5.2, 6.0, 8.2, and 8.3: Corrected inconsistent use of "shall" and "will".
- Typographical Corrections:
 - Sections 4.3.1 and 4.5.1: Corrected rogue colons in bullet point on the description of 911 calling limitation.
 - o Section 4.3.3: Removed unnecessary comma in the last bullet point.
 - o Sections 4.3.3, 4.5.3, and 5.2: Removed rogue periods at the ends of some mid-list bullet points.
 - o Footer on Clean Text version corrected to indicate "clean text" rather than "annotated".

Attached to this letter, please find updated annotated and clean text versions of the final proposed rule reflecting the changes. We look forward to discussing the final proposed rule at the upcoming June 29, 2023, meeting of LCAR.
