The Committee reviewed the following rules:

23-P31 – Department of Labor/Vermont Passenger Tramway Rules.

Dirk Anderson, Director of Workers' Compensation and Safety, Department of Labor explained the rule and answered questions from the Committee.

This rule adopts by reference the most recent industry standards.

On motion of Sen. MacDonald, the Committee approved the rule with modifications contained in the draft submitted by the Vermont Department of Labor under cover dated February 27, 2024.

23-P18 - Department of Public Safety/Vermont Fire Service Training Council.

Michael Skaza, Director and Chief of Training, Vermont Fire Academy, Division of Fire Safety, Department of Public Safety explained the rule and answered questions from the Committee. John Marcus, Chair, Vermont Fire Service Training Council was also present via Zoom.

This rule makes corrections to typographical errors, clarifies the annual date by which the Council may modify recertification requirements, and eases the requirements for granting firefighter certification through reciprocity from applicants who received their certification from other states.

On motion of Rep. Higley, the Committee approved the rule with the clarification that these rules shall become effective on March 15, 2024.
