5	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to provide that a
6	person shall not bring a court action based on a claim of nuisance arising from
7	an agricultural activity unless the person and the operator of the agricultural
8	activity, at least once, attempt to resolve through mediation the issue or dispute
9	that the person has concerning operation of the agricultural activity.
10	An act relating to protection from nuisance suits for agricultural activities
11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 12 V.S.A. § 5754a is added to read:
13	§ 5754a. REQUIRED MEDIATION PRIOR TO SUIT
14	(a) A person shall not bring a court action based on a claim of nuisance
15	arising from an agricultural activity unless the person and the operator of the
16	agricultural activity, at least once, attempt to resolve through mediation the
17	issue or dispute that the person has concerning operation of the agricultural
18	activity. The mediation shall be conducted according to the provisions of the
19	Uniform Mediation Act set forth in chapter 194 of this title.

1	(b) The parties to the mediation may agree upon the use of a mediator to
2	assist in the resolution of the agreed upon issue or dispute, and the parties shall
3	share the cost of the mediator. If the parties to the mediation are unable to
4	resolve the relevant issue or dispute through mediation, the parties may agree
5	to submit the issue or dispute to binding arbitration pursuant to chapter 192 of
6	this title and shall share the cost of the arbitration.
7	(c) A person bringing a court action based on a claim of nuisance arising
8	from an agricultural activity shall provide the court with a sworn statement of
9	an attempt to resolve the issue or dispute through mediation.
