## Pesticide Registration Classification per Vermont Rule for Control of Pesticides (CVR 20-031-012)

- Per Section 4 of the rule:
  - Pesticides are registered as one of three Classes
    - Class A: <u>State Restricted Use</u> Federally Restricted Use, or those that are intended for commercial or professional use, have high concentration of active ingredient, require specialize handling, neonicotinoids labeled for outdoor use, and others.
    - Class B: <u>Controlled Sale</u> turf products, pesticides intended for use outside of the home and not ready-to-use, and others.
    - Class C <u>Consumer Products</u> pesticides applied in and around residences and marketed as ready-to-use, Bti products, mosquito repellants, flea and tick products, and others.

Class A = 1,706 products currently registered

- Class B = 2,942 products currently registered
- Class C = 6,840 products currently registered

Registration is annual, December 1 – November 30

## Pesticide Dealer Classification per Vermont Rule for Control of Pesticides (CVR 20-031-012)

Per Section 3 of the rule:

Persons distributing pesticides must have a license issued by the Agency

Persons distributing Class A pesticides must have a Class A pesticide dealer's license and pass a written examination. Class A dealers can distribute Class A, Class B, and Class C pesticides. Class A dealers must maintain records of sales of Class A pesticides.

Persons distributing Class B pesticides must have a Class B pesticide dealer's license and pass a written examination. Class B dealers can distribute Class B, and Class C pesticides.

Persons distributing Class C pesticides must have a Retail/Class C license. There is no written examination. Class C pesticide dealers can only distribute Class C pesticides.
