



USDA NASS Statistics

- Production and yield per tap rebounded in 2022
- VT continues to significantly out-produce other NE states
- Accounts for ~1/2 of total US production

- Total value of production in 2021 was 56M
- Average price per gallon increased from 2020 to 2021

Trends from Atlantic Corp. Industry Report commissioned in 2021

"Identifying Market Opportunities for Vermont Maple Syrup Producers – 2021"

- 720 maple producers identified, 73 responded to survey
- Avg size of operation = 7,181 taps
- Size range: 40 to 91,000 taps
- Avg production = 3,342 gals
- Avg revenue = \$86,874 (skewed by the top earner)
- Median revenue = \$27,700

Note:

Trends from Atlantic Corp. Industry Report commissioned in 2021

"Identifying Market Opportunities for Vermont Maple Syrup Producers – 2021"

- Asked if satisfied with the current performance of their business. 1 = Extremely Dissatisfied,
 7 = Extremely Satisfied.
- Mostly were satisfied with their performance. Overall score was 5.1.

AAFM Maple Regulatory Program


- Conduct retail store inspections
- Respond to consumer complaints
- Provide regulatory technical assistance

2022 inspection results

- 19 inspections
- 59% of products "passed" inspection (n49)
- Most issues were minor/easily corrected
- A few significant issues also found
- Work with producers to correct issues when found
