AHS proposed change to Sec. 45 (33):

(33) \$18,778,775 to the Department for Children and Families to provide funding for the General Assistance Emergency Housing Program as specified in this subsection as follows:

(A) \$13,778,775 of these funds are for the purpose of providing temporary housing to vulnerable households as defined in this subdivision from April 1, 2023 through June 30, 2023. These funds are in addition to the amount of \$4,820,000 allocated within the appropriation listed in 2022 Acts and Resolves No. 185, \$ 53(b)(10) any additional expenditures for emergency housing funded through 2022 Acts and Resolves No. 185, \$ C.102. During this period, eligible households that seek temporary emergency housing shall receive it, regardless of the number of nights previously received or adverse weather conditions. The Department shall use the income and resource eligibility criteria in effect as of June 2021. A household is eligible if it meets one or more of the following:

* * *

(B) \$5,000,000 of these funds are for the purpose of providing temporary emergency housing from April 1, 2023 March 16, 2023 through May 31, 2023 for other households that are not eligible pursuant the criteria in subdivision (A) of this subdivision, but would be eligible for General Assistance emergency housing under the Adverse Weather Conditions policy in effect on January 15, 2023.
