2	The Committee on Appropriations to which was referred House Bill No. 31		
3	entitled "An act relating to Aquatic Nuisance Species Control" respectfully		
4	reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the Senate		
5	propose to the House that the bill be amended as follows:		
6	First: In Sec. 1, Aquatic Nuisance Control Study Committee; report, by		
7	striking out subsection (b) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the		
8	following:		
9	(b) Membership. The Aquatic Nuisance Control Study Committee shall be		
10	composed of the following members:		
11	(1) one current member of the House of Representatives, who shall be		
12	appointed by the Speaker of the House;		
13	(2) one current member of the Senate, who shall be appointed by the		
14	Committee on Committees;		
15	(3) the Commissioner of Health or designee;		
16	(4) a scientist from the Department of Fish and Wildlife, appointed by		
17	the Commissioner of Fish and Wildlife;		
18	(5) a scientist from the Department of Environmental Conservation,		
19	appointed by the Commissioner of Environmental Conservation; and		
20	(6) two scientists or researchers from the University of Vermont,		
21	appointed by the President of the University of Vermont, one with expertise in		

1	the potential human health impacts related to the invasives and control		
2	eradication and one with expertise in aquatic biology, including flora, fauna,		
3	and ecosystem health.		
4	Second: In Sec. 1, Aquatic Nuisance Control Study Committee; report, by		
5	striking out subsection (g) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the		
6	following:		
7	(g) Compensation and reimbursement.		
8	(1) For attendance at meetings during adjournment of the General		
9	Assembly, a legislative member of the Aquatic Nuisance Control Study		
10	Committee serving in the member's capacity as a legislator shall be entitled to		
11	per diem compensation and reimbursement of expenses pursuant to 2 V.S.A.		
12	§ 23 for not more than eight meetings. These payments shall be made from		
13	monies appropriated to the General Assembly.		
14	(2) Other members of the Study Committee shall be entitled to per diem		
15	compensation and reimbursement of expenses as permitted under 32 V.S.A. §		
16	1010 for not more than eight meetings. These payments shall be made from		
17	monies appropriated to the General Assembly.
